

Home School Student Access of Public School

Parents/guardians of non-enrolled Ashland Elementary School-aged residents must request the use of Ashland School District facilities in writing. The parents/guardians shall contact the principal of the Ashland Elementary School to request said permission. Permission to use District facilities will be considered provided that:

- a. There is space available.
- b. The activity does not interfere or disrupt educational activities of the school.
- c. Parents/guardians furnish written proof that students have met statutory requirements for immunizations and physical examinations.
- d. Students are subject to the same behavioral standards as regularly enrolled students.
- e. Parents/guardians are present while the student(s) are using the school.
- f. Parent/guardians have been fingerprinted and a background check completed.

Educational Materials

Parents/guardians of non-enrolled students may request the use of Ashland School District educational materials. The parents/guardians shall contact the principal of the Ashland Elementary School and request said materials in writing. All materials remain the exclusive property of the Ashland School District. The request to borrow educational materials will be considered provided that:

- a. There is educational material available.
- b. The request for use of the educational material does not interfere with the educational mission or the activities of the Ashland School District.
- c. Parents/guardians will be responsible for returning the materials in the same condition as received.

Field Trips

Parents/guardians of non-enrolled students may request that their child participate in an Ashland School District field trip. The parent/guardian shall make the request in writing to the principal of the Ashland Elementary School. Permission to participate on said field trip will be considered provided that:

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Field Trips (cont'd.)

- a. There is space available.
- b. The child's parent/guardian must be willing to serve as a chaperone for his or her child only for the specific field trip.
- c. The parents/guardian of the student will be responsible for any costs associated with the field trip.
- d. Students are subject to the same behavioral standards as regularly enrolled students.
- e. Parents/guardians will furnish written proof that students have met statutory requirements for immunizations and physical examinations.
